Description:

Responsibilities:

- Get fingerprinted, register as a volunteer at www.virtusonline.org, attend one of the diocesan Protecting God's Children classes, and keep up to date on monthly Protecting God's Children bulletins issued by Virtus.
- Attend 2 retreat planning meetings and become aware of ice breaker rules, small group themes & questions, and outline of each day's experience.
- If you have agreed to give a witness or catechetical presentation, then prepare and present your ideas to the retreat team prior to the retreat.
- Arrive 30mins prior to youth arrival to assist set-up and check in.
- Lead small groups
- Participate in Ice Breakers and other youth events and encourage participation.
- Facilitate a witness or catechetical presentation (if applicable).
- Help with check out and clean up after the retreat.
- Call 911 in case of an emergency.

Abilities Needed:

- Charisms of evangelism, faith, pastoring, or teaching.
- Love and respect for young people in our parish community.
- Commitment to being an example of the faith in your life.
- Patience and understanding with youth who are at all levels of spiritual development.
- Ability to work with others.
- Communication skills to give direction to youth and lead small groups.
- Sense of fun and adventure.
- Ability to adapt to changes in the retreat schedule.

Length of Commitment:

2 retreat meetings

The retreat evening from 3p-9p.

Supervision & Support:

Direct supervision will be provided by David Hall, Director of Youth Ministries.

Benefits of this Position:

You get to participate in fellowship building during the retreat. There may be opportunities for adoration, reconciliation, and Mass. You will be a witness and advocate as the youth's spiritual lives are deepened. You will experience a deepening of your own spiritual life.
