- Curricular and instructional practices are guided by current research and best professional

- A variety of instructional practices allow teachers to accommodate multiple learning styles, needs, and levels.
- As a Catholic school, our mission is to educate the whole child; therefore, we have taken the
 principals of Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (STEM) and infused Religion across all
 subjects and immersed the Arts (STREAM) to provide students the creative thinking skills
 necessary to communicate and advance STEM in the real world. STREAM is not a new
 curriculum, but a framework for intensive instruction. STREAM uses technology to advance the
 experience. Not only will students use traditional textbooks, but will also use various technological
 devices to explore, process, and learn.

Enhanced Technology

- St. Anthony of Padua is dedicated to the enhancement of technological education. Our classrooms are equipped with new computers, interactive projector systems, and one-to-one student devices.
- Included in your child's curriculum is a state-of-the-art Makerspace, which includes a Technology Center, Broadcasting Green Room, Sound Booth, and Fabrication Area with 3-D printing!
