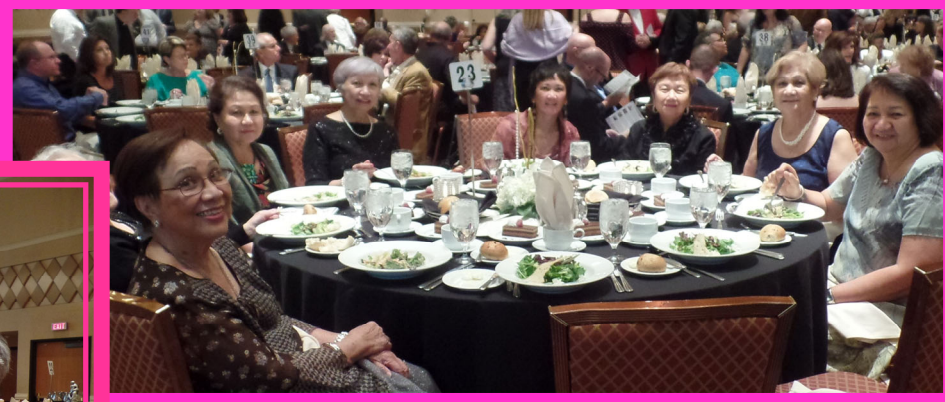
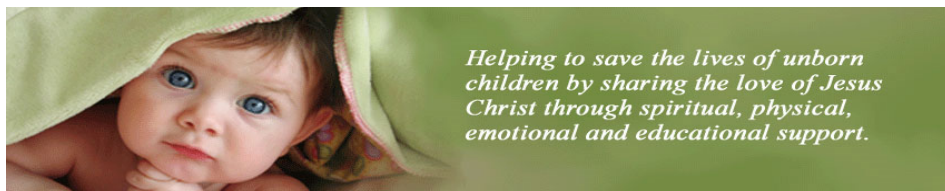

WHAT WE ACCOMPLISHED....

Due to your hard work and the involvement, we were able to accomplish the following during the 2015 Legislative Session:

Increased funding for public education by over \$500 million. This money will be appropriated for carefully designed programs that target the most disadvantaged children. This includes new programs for children living in poverty, English Language Learners, special education students and other important initiatives. We will continue to monitor the implementation of these programs.

Addressed the needs of seniors and their family caregivers. The CARE Act has been signed into law. This bill recognizes the important role of family caregivers and improves communication between hospitals and caregivers. We also increased the number of Medicaid Home and Community-Based Waiver slots by 173. These waivers enable low-income seniors to obtain in-home services and avoid being institutionalized.

We supported several other measures addressing topics such as guardianship, immigration, teaching scholarships and many more.

Together we are improving the quality of life for our community. We look forward to the work that we will do together in the coming months and years!
