we seek. We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen.”



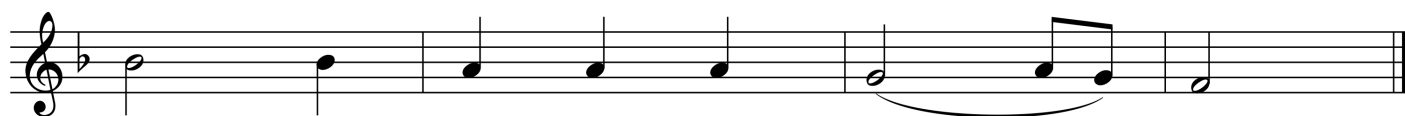
