- Prepare slideshows showcasing the retreat for students and families to view.
- Occasionally complete purchase orders if materials or prints need to be purchased.
- Call 911 in case of an emergency.

- The charisms of artistry, discernment, administration, writing, or faith.
- Love and respect for young people in our parish community.
- Commitment to being an example of the faith in your life.
- Patience and understanding with youth who are at all levels of spiritual development.
- Initiative and discernment to take pictures and video tactfully.

- Ability to adapt to changes in the retreat schedule.
